### **MONDAYS**

### Kaleidoscope Arts & Play – Culinary Focus (Ages 4–6)

### **TUESDAYS**

## Kaleidoscope Arts & Play – Sculpture Focus (Ages 4–6)

A playful session for young makers to build and create using clay, found objects, cardboard, and more! Children will learn about shapes, textures, and imaginative design while they sculpt colorful, tactile masterpieces.

## **I** Crafting Café (Ages 6−7) – Maija

A cozy, hands-on creative time where kids craft everything from felt animals to seasonal décor. The café vibe encourages imagination, conversation, and sharing, with each week offering a new fun project to take home.

### **WEDNESDAYS**

### Kaleidoscope Arts & Play – Theatre Games Focus (Ages 4–6)

An energetic afternoon for budding performers! Kids will play acting games, use costumes, and learn simple stories and skits—building confidence, imagination, and group play skills through theatre fun.

## **Mature Arts** (Ages 6–7) – Natalie

Kids will connect with nature through art—collecting leaves, sticks, and stones to craft natural sculptures, land art, and eco-friendly paintings. They'll discover the beauty in the world around them, rain or shine!

### 🧘 The Mindful Artist (Ages 7–11) – Taught by Sarah P

This calming, creative workshop invites young artists ages 7-11 to slow down and connect with their art and the world around them. Each session blends mindfulness practices—like simple breathing, gratitude circles, or nature walks—with hands-on projects that focus on sustainability and upcycled art. Kids will explore mindful painting, recycled collages, found-object sculptures, and nature journaling, learning to see everyday materials in new, thoughtful ways. Students will leave feeling proud of their creations and equipped with mindful tools they can use anytime they need a moment of calm.
